Hunts Preserve Hunt Lease Agreement

All Hunts must be "Paid in Full" upon arrival to Ranch before any hunts begin.

Hunting Rules

1. One half (1/2) deposit of total cost of hunt must be received before hunts will be reserved. If Lessee of a reserved hunt cancels his/hers reservation for any reason, his/hers deposit is non-refundable unless otherwise approved by Black Mountain Hunts L.L.C...
2. Lessee **agrees to Immediately** notify guide after a shot has been taken (hit or miss) of any weapon. Lessee agrees to check in all harvested and/or wounded animals with Black Mountain Hunts L.L.C. representatives. All wounded game (found or not found) will be paid at full price.
3. No self-tracking. You must wait for guide to arrive before tracking begins. Night tracking will stop once blood trail ends.
4. Hunting (Shooting) Hours are Sunrise to Sunset only No Exceptions. See back for the times you are here.

"Safety" is our primary rule at all times. We want everyone to have a great time and safely return home to their families.

- Hunter orange will be worn at all times while a Gun hunter is inside the High Fence Area by all participants. A minimum of a Hunter Orange vest is required.
- You may consume alcoholic beverages at the bunkhouse but please do not drink prior to any hunting activities. If you are drunk or appear to be drunk you will not be allowed to hunt.
- When hunting from a tree stand or elevated stand we strongly recommend you use a safety harness. Not using a safety harness can greatly increase your risk of injury or death in the event of a fall. You can use your own or we have a few for you. If you have questions on how to properly use a safety harness, please ask your guide for assistance.
- Guns are only allowed to be **"LOADED"** and **"UNLOADED"** inside the High Fence Area or the gun range! **NO "LOADED" guns in camp. "Do not shoot at anything outside the High Fence" You are responsible for your bullet or Arrow!**
- Two Bullet limit per hunter. You may carry a sidearm for finishing off your animal and protection only.
- Three arrow limit for Archery hunters. Hunter's initials must be on fletching. If you return from your hunt with less arrows than you carried into the High Fence Area, then each missing arrow will be considered a kill. If you miss and the arrow is recovered with no blood on it then you will not be charged for the kill once confirmed by the guide.
- No running Shots. A wounded animal is considered a kill and you will be charged a kill fee for the animal. Placing a good shot is your responsibility.
- **.243 Caliber or larger is required.** We suggest using the largest caliber you feel comfortable shooting for hog hunting. Multiple misses will require you to re-sight your weapon.
- Once you have harvested/or wounded your limit, **Your Hunt is Over.** You will not be allowed back into the High Fence with any weapon unless you pay for more hunts. There is absolutely no sharing of hunts within your group. You are allowed to return to the high fence area with your group without a weapon. Wounded animals can be taking by any remaining hunters or guides, so make your shot count.
- No Smoking is allowed inside the bunkhouse, Lodge, or while hunting. You may smoke outside the Lodge or bunkhouse but please dispose of butts properly.
- Don't leave anything inside the High Fence (food, trash, toilet paper or feces, etc.), as any scent left behind will not only affect your success but also the success of others. Please do not Litter.
- Any disregards of our rules will end your hunt immediately with no refund and you will be asked to leave.
- Please settle up your guide fees at the end of your hunt, 15% on the cost of your hunt is a good customary start. They work for you and not Black Mountain Hunts LLC. If you receive poor service contact me immediately @ 918-557-2444
